



DJSHOSA PARTICIPATES AT THE WHITESBOG BLUEBERRY FESTIVAL—JULY 22, 2023


Volunteers from the Dr. James Still Historic Office Site Association participated as a vendor at the 2023 Whitesbog Blueberry Festival.

DJSHOSA VOLUNTEER SERVICE DAY -NOVEMBER 11, 2023




FINGER KNITTING WORKSHOP-DECEMBER 17, 2023
